Registration is \$190 (US) and includes two breakfasts, 2 lunches, a dinner and entertainment on Friday night. You are encouraged to bring family members with you as the conference location is very family-friendly. Conference guests can register for \$150 which includes all of the above meals and entertainment.

Accommodations: The conference will be held at the Inverary Resort and MacAulay Conference Centre in Baddeck, Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia, Canada. The resort is located on 11 acres on the shores of the beautiful Bras d'Or Lakes with a full service spa, sauna, indoor pool, playground, tennis courts, and for a small fee you can rent bikes, canoes, kayaks, pedal boats, power boats, etc. There are a variety of accommodations available starting at \$115 (CAN) per night plus tax for a traditional room. Travel: Baddeck can be reached by many ways. The closest airport is in Sydney (airport code YQY), Cape Breton, about 1 hour away, and you can take a taxi from there. You can also fly into Halifax (airport code YHZ), which is a larger airport, and drive approximately 4 hours to Baddeck. A causeway connects Cape Breton Island to Nova Scotia. Rental cars are available at both the Halifax and Sydney airports. There are several shuttle services that go between Sydney and Halifax.
